#### **Old Business**

- The pool is now open. Maintenance repairs are being made.
  - As a reminder, alcohol and smoking are **not** permitted in the pool area (upper or lower deck).
  - O The pool closes at 8:00 p.m. sharp daily.
  - A full list of the current pool rules was passed out during the 2025 pool pass registration. Please read carefully.
- Final updates to the handbook are being finalized. Hard copies available upon request.
- Backyard birds (chickens, etc.) are not permitted as there is not sufficient amount of acreage per residence to support this.
- Game nights at the clubhouse are currently being considered.
- A suggestion to replace the basketball goal net is being considered.

# **New Business**

- HOA handbooks have been finalized with a summary of changes.
  - o Will be published shortly on HOA website. Hard copy available upon request.
- HOA newsletter will be published on even number months (example: next one scheduled August 2025).

- A new outdoor LED clock will be hung in the pool area.
  - A 15-minute alarm will be set at 7:45 p.m. to remind people to prepare to exit the pool area by 8:00 p.m.
  - o **The pool closes daily at 8 p.m. sharp.** Please adhere to this rule as repeat offenders will result in losing pool privileges for the remainder of the season.
  - o If you are among the last to leave the pool area, please help us out by closing the umbrellas. It will be greatly appreciated.

#### **Other Business**

- HOA will investigate doggy poop service that provides waste bags. However, all residents and tenants are responsible for picking up after their animal regardless of the HOA providing this courtesy service. It is a violation of the City of Blue Springs regulations, and you will be reported and fined.
  - All dogs must be on a leash when not secured on your property. Any loose animals will be reported to animal control promptly.
- There was a resident concern regarding the heaviness of the pool gate.
  - o The gate is designed to prevent children from opening and closing
  - The HOA will explore options to improve gate management, but it is not guaranteed.
- There was a resident concern regarding a neighbor with no gutters and rodents entering the home.
  - This is under investigation.
- We ask that you please do not feed the squirrels and the rabbits. They are so cute but have also inundated the neighborhood. Squirrels can cause a significant amount of damage to a home if they find a nesting place on your property.

  - We welcome actionable, constructive feedback. If you have a problem or concern, please provide specific suggestions for improvement.
- The HOA currently accepts Zelle, check, cashier's check, money orders, and credit/debit cards for HOA dues, fees and fines. *A 3% fee applies to credit/debit card transactions*.
  - If you are delinquent with any dues, fees, or fines, please contact Area Real Estate to make payment arrangements to bring your account current.
